Residency or Address Requirement	Mailing address required; unsheltered residents can use various addresses to establish residency for voter registration purposes, such as a shelter address, a description of a location where they usually stay, or an address where they can receive mail, such as a P.O. box or a friend's or family member's address.
ID requirement	Either your driver's license number or the last four digits of your Social Security number on your Arkansas Voter Registration Application, or check the box in #9 on the application to indicate that you do not possess either a driver's license or Social Security number.

Mail-in Registration Deadline	Postmarked by Sunday, October 6, 2024

In-Person Voting: Tuesday, November 5, 2024	When voting in-person on Election Day in Arkansas, you must present a valid photo ID. Acceptable forms of ID include a driver's license, state ID card, passport, or a military ID. Voters without an ID can vote provisionally and must return with an ID for the vote to be counted
Absentee or Mail-in Voting Deadline: October 29th, 2024	October 29th, 2024 – Arkansas voters must request an absentee ballot at least 7 days before Election Day. You can apply for an absentee ballot through your County Clerk's office or online via the Arkansas Secretary of State's website. Absentee ballots must be returned by 7:30 p.m. on Election Day.
Early Voting	Early voting in Arkansas begins 15 days before the election and ends on the day before the election. For the 2024 election, early voting will start on Monday, October 21st, 2024, and will end on Monday, November 4th, 2024. Early voting locations and hours can be confirmed with your County Clerk's office.
